Are you a member? Have you voted? OC chapter election has begun and soon will be over. If you have not voted, please do. The chapter would like to induct the new officials on September 30.

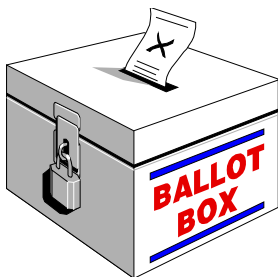

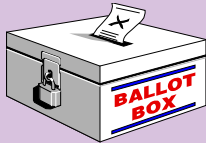
